Introduction

This Tournament will be carried out using the sportdata platform. Many successful tournaments have been carried out with this platform which also is the one that provides the official ITF scoring system.

Categories

- The Tournament will have different categories separated by age and sex.
- The maximum number of competitors by categories is of 32.
- The categories may be divided or united according to the needs of the Tournament Committee
- The patterns will be established for each category.

Individual Patterns - Female y Masculine

Ages:

- Kids: 10-11(2009-2010)
- Pre-Juniors: 12-14 (2006-2008)
- Juniors: 15-17 (2003-2005)
- Senior: 18-35 (1985-2002)
- Advanced Senior: 36-45 (1975-1984)
- Veterans: 46 + (1974 or below)

Categories:

- Green-Blue Stripe
- Blue-Red Stripe
- Red-Black Stripe
- 1er Degree
- 2do Degree
- 3er Degree
- 4to a 6to Degree

Prearranged Sparring – Mixed

(Couples can be of the same sex or not)

- 10 to 14 years. 1st to 3rd Dan (kids & pre-juniors)
- 15 to 17 years 1st to 3rd degree
- 18 to 35 years 1st to 6th degree.
- 36 to 45 years 1st to 6th degree.
- +46 years 1st to 6th degree.

Team Patterns – 5 members Female/Male

- 0 to 14 years. 1st to 3rd Dan (kids & pre-juniors)
- 15 to 17 years 1st to 3rd degree.
- 18 to 35 years 1st to 6rd degree.
- 36 to 45 years 1 to 6th degree.
- +46 years 1st to 6th degree.

Tournament System

- The Tournament will be ruled by the simple elimination system.
- The winner of each match advances to the next round.

Registration

Competitors

For registration, each **Team/Club** must register their competitors on the sportdata system.

The coaches will have to registrate on sportdata with a **Team/Club account**.

The ones with an existent Team/Club account will have to reuse that one (this allows to reuse the profiles of the competitors)

Steps to follow:

1. Login in the account
2. Verify the Team/Club data
3. Enter the competitor's data (or actualize them)
4. Look for the 1st Virtual PanAmerican in the events calendar and click the event registration button.
5. Do the competitors registration

Entries will remain on waiting list until the payment and authorization process is completed.

Once the registration time is closed there will not be money refund.

Umpires

Each national or allied association will be able to present a list of umpires to officiate at the tournament. The steps are the following:

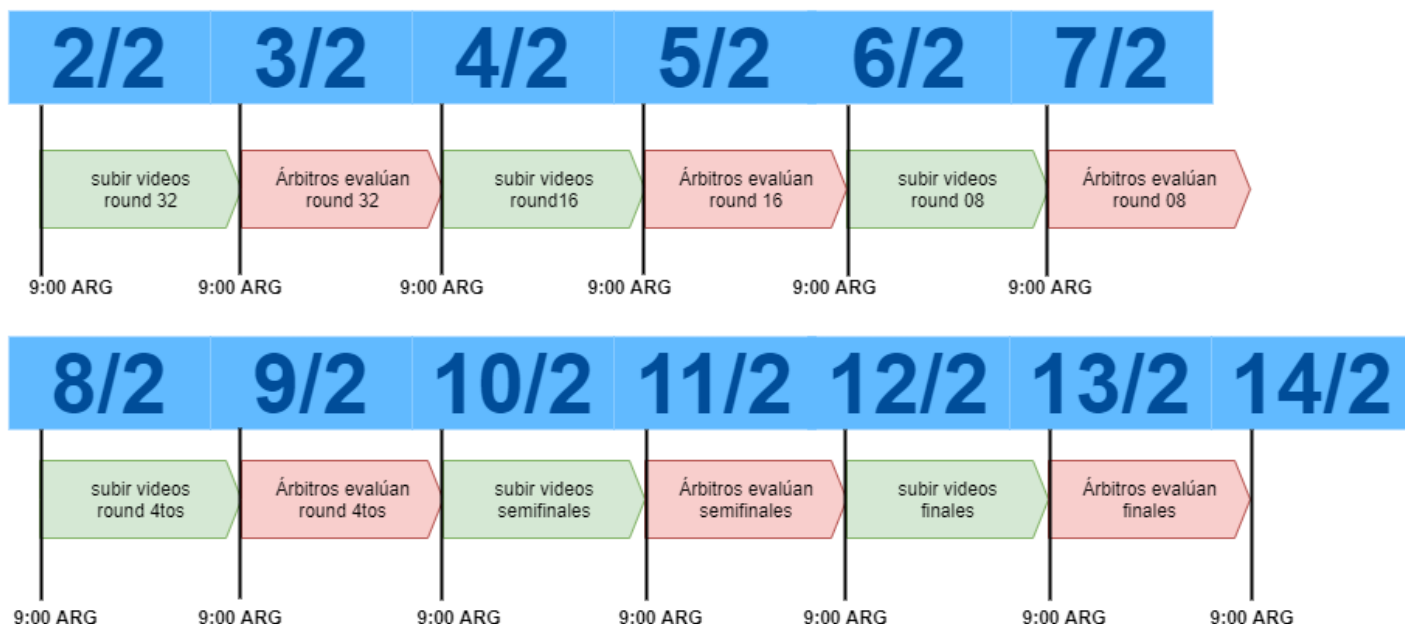
Request a registration user and password to the organization and upload all the umpires.

Each umpire must individually register on sportdata and join to the tournament (an instructive will be provided).

Umpires will be on waiting list for approval or not by the tournament umpire committee
Registrants will receive a letter informing their acceptance or not as umpires.

Schedule

- One day before the start, all draws will be published, and the participants informed.
- A detailed timetable will be published before the start on the event page.
- Each coach must record and send the videos within 24 hours of each round.
- Once the video is sent, it will be validated to make sure it meets the requirements.
- Once the videos are approved, the judges have 24 hours to evaluate them and give a winner.
- This process continues until the end of the tournament.



Attention!

If the video does not meet the requirements, the match is lost.

Videos Upload

Videos must be uploaded within 24 hours of each round (according to the established schedule). At the beginning of each video you must show the match code of the day. This code is modified with each round. The video must not have cuts and the competitor cannot leave the screen at any time.

The platforms enabled to upload the videos are:

CodePen, DailyMotion, Deviantart, Facebook, Flickr, GettyImages, Gfycat, Giphy, Hulu, Instagram, Kickstarter, Livestream, Meetup, Reddit, Scribd, Sketchfab, Slideshare, SoundCloud, SpeakerDeck, Spotify, Ted, Twitch, Twitter, Vimeo, Wordpress, Youtube.

Patterns to perform

- **Gups categories** will perform an optional pattern between **Won Hyo** and their current graduation (for a red belt it could be up to Hwa Rang).
- **Black Belts: kids and veterans** will complete a ***designated*** of the three corresponding to its category
- **Black Belts: Pre-Junior, junior, seniors and advanced seniors** will compete with **two (2) designated** forms, one among their category and one drawn between Chon-Ji and the last form of their graduation (excluding the one drawn first).
